- B) Process for ordering, paying, organizing School luncheons was created and sent to members. Will be held in school scc folder. (hot dog lunch vs a bought pizza lunch and what that entails)
- C) Information was sent to SCC regarding the Board supplied SCC parent engagement/SCC operating funds monies and account – account is held at the Melfort Credit Union – thanks to the SCC executive members that went to get signing authority currently
- D) Information on the account held at the school level – for SCC fundraising was explained and sent to members.
  - a. One account that is solely run by the SCC – called a parent engagement/scc operating account. This account is held at the credit union, and deposits of money come from the school division, who have a formula based on a student #..each year they add to it and would like to see it near depleted each year. It has increased in size due to two years of covid. Only SCC parent members can allocate funds from this account via a motion and two signatures from the group. The credit union sends the balance to the school where the treasurer picks it up and updates the group. Currently at \$3706.
  - b. The second account is an SCC fundraising account that gets deposits from fundraising. The money is held in the overall school account and is monitored by the division. The goal is to utilize Fundraised money in an appropriate amount of time so parents on the SCC – there kids get to enjoy the fruits of the fundraised labor. Only the principal can sign for expenditures from this account, which are then second approved by the division accounting clerks. Kendra is able to acquire the balance from her computer at anytime to give to the treasurer, who can update the group. Currently at \$991.
- E) Scholastic Book Fair was a huge success. Erin and Candace were in to sign the \$500 cheque for the parent student activity related book fair gift certificates!
